(1) Internship Program:

KTLN TV 68’s Internship Program offers internships to college students and other individuals actively pursuing a career in the broadcast television industry. The program is designed to introduce students and others to broadcasting careers and to assist them with acquiring skills needed for broadcast employment. Students receive college credit for their participation in the program. Internship opportunities are posted with local universities, colleges, churches and community organizations. In addition, information regarding KTLN TV’s internship program may be found on the KTLN TV 68’s website, www.ktln.tv.

Program Details:

- We are committed to giving our interns valuable experience in all aspects of broadcast television at KTLN including office, ministry, audio, lighting, basic non-linear editing, cameras, and set design / construction.
- No structured learning sessions should be expected. The intern is encouraged to ask questions and learn from watching, listening, and when approved, “hands on” experience.
- Interns will agree in advance to a start and end date.
- An eight-hour weekly minimum is required. KTLN will also honor time requirements of each college, university, or organization.
- Scheduled work hours will be determined before acceptance. These hours can be flexible to meet the student’s need in attending classes or candidates other obligations, but shc meet a set, agreed upon, schedule.
- This Internship Program only applies to broadcast television production and related assignments at KTLN. It does not apply to computer science, or management.

- KTLN does not offer paid internships.

(4) Training Program for Staff

KTLN TV established and maintains a training program designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions. KTLN employs 8 full time positions. Through BAVC, KTLN sent 3 staff members for formal training on Final Cut systems, production, engineering, and other field related courses. Staff members select the courses at their discretion and determine the number of courses for participation.
